WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

- Attend two training sessions – 1st approximately 90 minutes in length / 2nd one hour.
- Report to work at 5:30 am on Election Day and serve until all duties are completed after the closing and securing of the polls at 8:30 pm.
- All Precinct Election Officials are responsible to help in the set up.
- Verify voter eligibility.
- Process voters.
- Issue ballots to voters.
- Other miscellaneous clerical duties.
- Able to Lift up to 35 lbs. with assistance and pack up all supplies after the polls close at 7:30 pm.
- Every effort is made to place you at a convenient location whenever possible.
