

Q. When should I expect to receive my ballot?

A. We began sending ballots on Tuesday, October 6th, however, due to the volume of ballots being larger than anticipated it is taking slightly longer than expected to get the ballots in the mail. Please remain patient as we are working diligently to ensure each voter gets the proper ballot in the timeliest manner possible.

Q. Where and when can I vote early in-person?

A. Early voting will take place at our new Early Voting Center at 2911 Youngstown Rd SE, right next to the Board of Elections at the old Chase Bank building. The in-person early voting calendar can be found here: https://boe.co.trumbull.oh.gov/boe_earlyvote.html

Q. What if I received an absentee ballot and I choose not to vote it and go to the polls instead?

A. If a ballot is mailed to you and you change your mind and go to your polling place to vote on Election Day, you will be required to vote a provisional ballot that cannot be counted until at least 11 days after Election Day.

A. We have a secure 24 hour drop box right outside our front door that is always available for use.
